- Do you inspire trust from your panel?

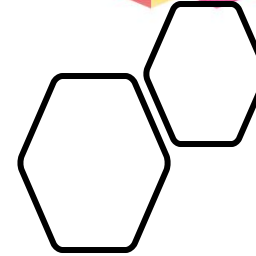
