Good Information Handling Principles

- Fair and lawful processing
- Data obtained for specified lawful purposes
- Personal data shall be:
 - ✓ adequate, relevant and not excessive
 - ✓ accurate and kept up to date
 - √ kept for no longer than necessary
 - ✓ processed in accordance with data subject rights
- Security principle unauthorised/unlawful processing
